Arrival & Dismissal Routines

Walkers-Please park in the Marshall St. lot and wait at the grassy area by the playground gate to sign in

Active Drop-off/pick-up- Drive into lot and join queue along playground fence. Remain in your car and staff will help your child from the car to their group at arrival, and secure them in their carseat at dismissal.



Camp Health Policy:

Campers cannot attend if any of these symptoms apply within the past 24 hours: Fever of 100+ degrees, vomiting, diarrhea, testing positive for strep, the flu, RSV, or Covid. Campers must be symptom-free for 24 hours without the aid of medication before attending.

Epipen/Inhaler/Medication: require a written Individual Health Care Plan Director must be notified before your child attends to coordinate care.

Please call us by 8:45am if your child will not be at camp for any reason.

What will my child's day look like?

9-9:30-arrival, morning circle

9:30-10- waterplay

10-10:30-enrichment

10:30-11- snack

11-11:30-playground

11:30-12- closing circle, dismissal



Extended day*

12-12:45- lunch

12:45-1:30-storytime, choice time

1:30-2:00-outdoor play, dismissal

*Please pack a peanut/tree-nut free lunch and beverage that does not require refrigeration. Label all lunchboxes and water bottles.

Registration reminders:

- An enrollment form and updated physical with immunizations must be on file before your child can attend
- Campers must meet the min. age for their group by June 1st and be fully potty trained (no pull-ups or diapers)

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
