What will my child's day look like?

9am- Arrival- The main entrance for Kid Connection is on the upper level of the Mystic School. Please park in the Marshall St parking lot and we will meet you at the gate to the playground. Please be sure to check your child in with a Vacation Club teacher.

(If it is raining, please walk your child up the stairs to door #3. There is a buzzer to the left of the door, but we will be expecting you! You may also enter through the Madison Ave upper-level doors)

9:30-10:30am- Story, group activity (art, game, science, etc.)

10:30-11:00- Bathroom break, Snack

11:00-12:00- table activities, choice time (possibly gym or outdoor play)

12-12:30- lunch

12:30-1:00- clean-up, story time

1:00-2:00pm- outdoor play, depending on weather

2:00pm- dismissal-We will meet you at the gate to the parking lot. Anyone approved to pick up your child must be listed on the enrollment form. We will ask for an ID. Thank you!

What should my child bring? (Please label everything!)

- A nut-free snack and water bottle
- A nut-free lunch that does not require refrigeration or reheating
